**CLASS DISTRIBUTION NOTICE # 2 TO PROVISIONAL CLASS MEMBERS
STATUS OF DISTRIBUTION**

**THIS NOTICE CONTAINS IMPORTANT INFORMATION
CONCERNING WHO WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A
SHARE OF THE NET COMMON FUND OF AN ESTIMATED
\$74,000,000 FOR UNPAID INDIRECT COSTS FOR FY 1989
THROUGH FY 1993.**

A. IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE "SHORT LIST"

On January 7, 2000, you were sent a Notice with an attached Provisional Class List. The list was also published in Vol. 65 *Federal Register*, Feb. 2, 2000, page 4989. That listing included the names of all tribes and tribal entities which on information and belief at that time

might conceivably qualify for a share. Since then we and the Class' Independent CPA Rogoff Erickson Diamond & Walker, LLP, of Albuquerque, NM, have compiled data and collected information enabling us to revise the list to remove those tribes and entities which we now believe will not qualify to receive a share of the Net Common Fund and to add certain other tribes and tribal entities which we now believe may qualify for a share. Enclosed with this notice is a schedule derived from the Second Revised Preliminary Insufficient Data List filed May 16, 2000, containing a approximately ~~356~~³⁴⁹ names comprising the "Short List". The purpose of this notice is to give tribes and tribal entities who are not on the revised list another chance to submit proof of eligibility for a share.

The prime reason for dropping tribes or tribal entities from the original list was because records provided by BIA and Office of Inspector General (OIG) did not identify them as having had an OIG approved indirect cost rate or a BIA approved lump sum agreement for contract support costs during any of the settlement years, FY1989 through FY1993. Other tribes and entities were removed because, although they qualify for membership in the class, they have no record of receiving funds from other federal agencies, the basis on which allocations will be issued.

If your tribe or tribal entity is not included on the enclosed list it may still submit proof to the CPA that it meets the requirements for receiving a share of the Net Common Fund. There are two practical conditions for eligibility to receive a share:

1. That the entity be a member of the Class as shown by having had an indirect cost rate with OIG or lump sum agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for at least one of the settlement years which, under the settlement agreement, serves to establish that the entity had a

Public Law 93-638 self-determination contract, grant, compact, or Public Law 100-297 school grant; and

2. That the entity have received funds from other federal agencies (not including IHS or BIA) during the same settlement year.

Proof of these conditions may be in the form of:

a. Your indirect cost agreement with OIG or lump sum agreement with the BIA, or the equivalent, such as a contract modification, a letter from the BIA or OIG recognizing an old IDC rate for one of the years in question, or a BIA advice of allotment showing payment of indirect costs or lump sum for contract support for one or more of those years will establish your Class membership.

b. Your Schedule of Federal Financial Assistance from your single agency audit for the years you had an IDC rate agreement or a lump sum agreement with the BIA. This Schedule contains information showing what funds your organization received from other federal agencies. If this schedule is not available, you may submit a copy of your indirect cost or lump sum agreement for that year (if it shows such receipts) or proof of receipt of payment from another federal agency such as an advice of allotment or a grant award. This information will establish each Class member's ratio for a share of the Net Common Fund for each settlement year.

B. IF YOU ARE ON THE "SHORT LIST" BUT HAVE MISSING DATA

On May 8, 2000, the tribes and tribal entities on the enclosed short list were sent a letter containing specific information as to their status showing for which years the requisite information has been received and for which years it is missing. If your organization received

such a letter showing it has submitted data for one or more years, but not all five years, you may submit further documentation for the missing years. You may also submit further documentation in response to this notice even if you did not receive the letter.

Although the BIA and OIG are also required to search for certain missing audit data under Paragraph 9(b) Appendix D of the Partial Settlement Agreement for those tribes on the short list, it is best if the tribes and tribal entities themselves search for and submit their own data. For this reason it is very important that your organization make another effort to search its files and contact its Contracting or Awarding Officer or local BIA office for the missing audit data or IDC documents.

At this time we have received complete data for each of the settlement years from ~~approximately~~ ^{COVER} one-half of the short list and some data for one or more settlement years for most of the remaining tribes or tribal entities. We have thus determined that the present distribution system is viable for the actual distribution of the net common fund, subject to court approval. Even though we believe we have sufficient responses to allow us to use the original distribution system set out in the Partial Settlement Agreement, we would like as many tribes and tribal entities as possible to qualify for a share and hence urge your organization to participate as requested.¹

¹ However, if your tribe or entity did not have an OIG IDC rate or a BIA lump sum agreement for any of the settlement years, your organization is not a member of the class for those years and therefore is not eligible to receive a share of the net common fund, even if it had a self-determination contract, grant, compact, or school grant and received funds from other federal agencies. DCA-Cognizant tribes may qualify under a separate agreement up to a specific aggregate amount. Separate notices will be sent to DCA tribes to indicate eligibility requirements for that separate allocation.

We ask that you submit proofs as described in this Notice no later than June 19, 2000 to the class Independent CPA Rogoff Erickson Diamond & Walker, LLP, P.O. Box 93659, Albuquerque, NM 87199-3659. You should direct any inquiries about this notice to the CPA at 1-888-726-9418. Specific information about your tribe's or entity's status may be found on the CPA's website for this case: www.rncsettlement.com.

The Class has hired the Santa Fe accounting firm of Keckler & LeCompte, P.C., as its monitor for the distribution process, as authorized by the Partial Settlement Agreement.

The Court has scheduled a Status Conference to review the status of the distribution process for July 6, 2000, at 11:00 a.m., at the Federal Courthouse, Albuquerque, New Mexico (Judge C. LeRoy Hansen). If you wish to attend the Status Conference please phone the Clerk at (505) 348-2000 to confirm.

ORDER THAT NOTICE BE SENT TO CLASS


